



# **Master of Science in Nursing**

# **College of Natural Sciences, Department of Nursing**

The Department of Nursing offers a hybrid online program leading to the Master of Science degree with a major in Nursing. Every student completes a series of core courses and selects from one of three concentrations/specializations: Advanced Community/Public Health Nursing, Population-Based Nursing, and Nurse Educator. Students choosing full-time plans of study typically complete the degree in two to two-and-one-half academic years.

#### **Concentrations/Specializations**

- The specialization in **Advanced Community/Public Health** prepares the graduate to deliver expert nursing care to community-based populations in positions in public health departments, home health agencies, and other community-based organizations.
- The **Population-Based Nursing** specialization prepares the graduate to apply a populationfocused perspective in delivering expert nursing care in a wide range of clinical settings including hospitals, ambulatory settings, skilled nursing facilities, and more.
- The **Nurse Educator** specialization prepares the graduate for nurse educator positions in both academic and clinical settings.
